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Dear Parents/Carers,

We are currently in the process of setting up a new after school extracurricular clubs system. This will work in the same way that booking for parents evening runs. You will be allocated a log in code which will then allow you to book a space in an extracurricular club for your child, should they wish to attend.

We have a really exciting range of clubs to offer this year which will start after the October half term and will run at various times throughout the year. Staff run these clubs through good will and enjoy sharing their talents and skills with the children. We aim to include a range of clubs throughout the year to each year group so as the children move through the school they will have the option to try new things in each year group. Due to Magic Moments using the hall and the large playground we do not have the option to run as many sports clubs as we would like to, however with our field now in a good condition we have tried to increase the number we can offer. Mr Weston is also running a range of sports clubs at lunchtime for pupils in KS2 and this includes a new range of sports for the children to try such as Handball, Ultimate Frisbee, Tri-Golf and many more. You do not need to book spaces on these lunchtime sports clubs as they are offered to all pupils and will rotate, so each KS2 class gets a chance to attend.

A letter will be coming out shortly with the clubs available to each year group, the days and times it will be running and the number of places available. Once the online booking system goes live it's important to book quickly to avoid disappointment as there are limited spaces for each club. There are also non-sports clubs running at lunchtime alongside Mr Weston's sports clubs that your child might like to attend.

If your child is allocated a place at an extracurricular club, staff will share with them, during the first session, the following expectations. We would also ask you to read and follow them.

- Clubs are still part of what we do here in school - the same behaviour expectations are in place as are the three school rules
- Non-attendance for more than two sessions may lead to the space being re-allocated.
- Parents must phone the office and let staff know if their child will not be attending so time isn't spent trying to find out where they are
- Children must be collected by the allocated time of finish. If this is not adhered to your child's space may be withdrawn
- For pupils in Year Five and Six you may choose for your child to walk down the drive/up High House Drive to meet you, if this is the case then staff will require a signed letter of permission to say you allow this to happen
- There is no space for parking on site even after school. Parents collecting from clubs must park on Old Birmingham Road. Failure to follow this request may also lead to your child's space being withdrawn

Staff are very much looking forward to starting their clubs with the children.
