Dear Parents/Carers,

We are extremely proud of our children here at LHPSN and their super behaviour. We often get positive comments, such as how polite, well mannered and sensible our pupils are, from visitors and when children have been out on educational visits. Our three school rules are now firmly embedded and staff consistently remind the children of our behaviour expectations throughout the day.

As you know, the Senior Leadership Team issue red card letters to children who break our school rules. We are now introducing yellow card letters that can be issued by class teachers. These are for those children for whom a red card letter would not be appropriate but who have demonstrated other behaviours which we believe parents should know about.

If your child receives a yellow card letter we would appreciate your support in reinforcing why the behaviour is not acceptable in school. You don't need to contact the class teacher to discuss the incident further as the yellow card letter is a way of informing you that the incident has been addressed by staff and is now closed. We inform our children that each new day is a fresh start. Yellow card letters will not be accompanied by phone calls home as staff will be unable to leave the class to make them. We do ask, as with red cards, that you return the slip at the bottom to acknowledge that you have received the letter.

Our Positive Discipline Policy, which is published on the school website, has been updated to include this addition. We believe that a consistent approach across school is most effective and enables our children, teachers and senior leaders to work together with clear understanding of the expectations.

We continue to reward good behaviour with stickers, golden tickets, star of the week, half termly awards, house points and Headteacher golden book and Headteacher stickers to encourage all children to be the best they can.
