

Dear Parents/Carers

We would like to thank you for your continued support throughout Oliver's illness this year.

Oliver is now moving into the maintenance stage of his leukaemia treatment. This will continue for the next two and a half years where he will be immune compromised.

We are hoping Oliver can now start a phased return to school in year 6 however, this will be determined by his health and any illnesses in school.

Please may we ask for your support in an important matter?

Please can you let school know immediately if your child is suspected of having any illnesses including chicken pox, measles, shingles, sickness and diarrhoea as these are very dangerous to Oliver.

With regards to chicken pox he would need to be given an injection within three days of contact. If your child is suspected of having chicken pox, please let school know ASAP.

It is also important that you let school know if there is shingles in your household.

Your child is not at any risk whatsoever from this situation. We do not wish for you to keep your child away from school unnecessarily but if we can be made aware of any illnesses then we can make a decision as to whether we send Oliver to school.
