Year 6 particularly enjoying making electric-powered cars while Year 4 have learned about scientist Alessandro Volta and recreated his electrical experiments that resulted in his invention of the battery. Year 3 have been looking at forces, including testing how the Egyptians moved stones and exploring magnetic poles. Meanwhile, LB2 have been investigating sound, including conducting a noise survey of the whole school. Finally, Year 5's space topic came to a close as they analysed samples of "Martian" soil as well as investigating the formation of craters.
