Dear Families.

The school Christmas tree is up, the excitement has started and there are Christmas songs starting to fill the corridors again. We are so pleased that we can celebrate Christmas in school this year and very much look forward to welcoming you all safely into school over the coming weeks for the Christmas nativities (KS1), Language base Christmas event and Songs Around the Christmas Tree (Nursery and Reception). The dates and times of all events are on the school website and this newsletter so please make a note. As you know, we have had to make changes to the way we organise the events this year. With cases rising again in school we have ensured we have minimised the number of households mixing as much as we can. Our events are by class rather than key stage which means we can use the space our hall provides for effective ventilation and distancing. Each family has been allocated two tickets, you will need to bring this on the day/evening of the event. We can only accommodate two tickets per family. The total number arriving for the performances must not exceed two. It means that you may allocate a ticket to an adult and a sibling, but not two adults and then bring siblings with you. We will also ask you to wear a face covering in the school hall, unless you are exempt, and use the sanitiser provided. These decisions are never easy but I must act in the best interests of the children and staff and guidance from the local authority so that everyone can enjoy a safe and happy Christmas holiday with their families and friends.

I know you will enjoy seeing your children perform, we are all very excited to be able to celebrate together.




