Take the first steps to becoming a Teaching Assistant

Worcestershire County Council is offering online courses to help guide adult learners on the right path to becoming a teaching assistant. The Level 2 Award in Support Work in Schools aims to develop the essential skills and knowledge needed to provide support in a school environment, including safeguarding and communication methods.

The courses, which start on Wednesday 5 January and Tuesday 1 March, are open to anyone to join, regardless of previous qualifications, and a work placement isn't required, with those meeting criteria able to sign up for free.

Worcestershire County Council are also offering free Support Teaching & Learning Advice Appointments for those wanting to find out more about becoming a teaching assistant from qualified and experienced teaching staff.

The closing date for applications for a place in all First and Primary Schools is Saturday 15 January 2022.

If you haven't done so already can you please ensure that you submit your application on-line using the Worcestershire Children First - Citizen

If you are unable to make your application using the on-line system, please contact School Admissions on 01905 822700 to request an application form. Please note, this application should also be received by School Admissions by Saturday 15 January 2022.

It is vitally important that your application is made before the closing date. Late applications receive a lower priority which could mean that you are not offered a place at your preferred school.

If you live in Birmingham and pay your council tax to Birmingham (rather than Bromsgrove Council) you should apply through the Birmingham portal.
