At LHPSN, we want to grow young people who believe in themselves so they are confident, courageous and resilient when faced with challenges. Our ethos and curriculum encourages perseverance, responsibility and community. We encourage all learners to set aspirational goals in learning and life: To dream, believe and achieve. Our school values are at the heart of everything we do at Lickey Hills Primary School and reflect the qualities that staff and governors want our children to develop and express in their learning and play.

We value the voice of our pupils and parents, it ensures we are a continuously improving school with safety and wellbeing underpinning all we do. It also enables us to work in partnership with you to encourage LHPSN children to dream, believe and achieve their goals and ambitions. We recognise there are times when concerns arise so we encourage you to speak with class teachers, safeguarding leads and senior leaders to ensure all children feel safe and happy in school and ready to learn.

At LHPSN we will:

- Provide a nurturing environment and keep it as safe as we reasonably can with the resources we have
- Treat all children courteously, consistently and fairly.
- Provide opportunities to listen to the views of children and parents, and inform parents of children's progress regularly.
- Encourage the children by rewarding and celebrating good work and behaviour.
- Make learning exciting and create a happy learning environment where children feel safe and secure.
- Keep parents informed of school activities through regular letters and newsletters.
- Set regular home learning and spellings.

As a child at LHPSN I will:

- Work hard and behave well inside and outside school following the Three School Rules
- Find out what opportunities are available to me and take part wherever possible
- Find somebody I know to talk to if I have any worries

As a LHPSN family we will:

- Ensure our child attends regularly (above 95% target attendance) and on time.
- Children will wear uniform and ensure they bring a coat each day. They should be fully equipped for school (Children should not bring additional toys).
- Let the school know straight away of any absence; avoiding family holidays in school time.
- Not post or encourage any offensive slanderous comments on any social media site about any child, parent, carer or professional at this school or the school itself.
- Support the school's policies and guidelines for behaviour.
- Ensure the school has up to date medical information for my children and will be responsible for ensuring in date medication is in school.
- Ensure the school has up to date contact information in case of an emergency
- Ensure our child has a healthy breakfast, packed lunch/school hot dinner, and water bottle with plain water for use in school.
- Attend Parents' Evenings and discussions about our child's progress and ensure that home/school communication is the best it can be.
- Encourage our child to do their best and take part in the many opportunities that school life has to offer.
- Support our child in homework and other opportunities for home learning including reading 3 times a week each week, which is signed in your reading diary, learn weekly set spellings and complete weekly maths home learning.
- We will park responsibly without blocking residential driveways, on double yellow lines or on grass verges.
