Online Safety agreement for KS2 Pupils September 2023

When I am using the computer or other technologies, such as mobile phones or tablets, I want to feel safe all of the time

I agree that I will:

- Ask permission from an adult before using the Internet.
- Only use age appropriate websites and search engines that I have discussed and agreed with a responsible adult.
- Always talk to an adult if I'm not sure about something or if something happens online that makes me feel worried or frightened.
- Immediately close any web page I am not sure about.
- Not use technology to be unkind to people.
- Never give out personal information or passwords. (Personal information includes: my name, family information, journey to school, my pets and hobbies)
- Understand that any pictures or videos that are posted on the Internet/social media sites will be there forever. I will always check with a parent/carer first, to check that any pictures/videos are appropriate and the internet site/social media outlet is legally suitable for my age.
- Only talk to people online if I know them in real life.
- Never arrange to meet anyone I don't know in real life.
- Read and talk about these rules with my parents/carers.
- I understand that the school safeguarding leads will monitor and filter my use of the school computers and can see what has been searched and/or written by me. I understand that this is to keep me and all of the children and staff safe.

I understand that once I share anything online it is completely out of my control and may be used by others in a way that I did not intend and that anything I share online may be monitored.

Children:

I have listened to and understood the pupils e-safety agreement and I will follow the rules, which are there to keep me and the school safe

Parents/carers:

I have read and understood the e-safety agreement and give permission for my son / daughter to access the Internet at school, and will encourage them to abide by these rules. Children will receive advice on e-safety at school.

Advice for parents is available at <u>www.thinkuknow.org.uk/parents</u> or by contacting the school. I understand that the school will take reasonable precautions to ensure pupils cannot access inappropriate materials.

I will encourage my child to adopt safe use of the internet and digital technologies at home and will inform the school if I have concerns over my child's e-safety. When I am given specific permission by the school to take photos at events I will ensure that any pictures taken that include other children will not be shared using social media.
