Online Safety Agreement - Reception and KS1 Pupils

When I am using the computer or other technologies, such as mobile phones or tablets, I want to feel safe all the time.

When I use a computer, a tablet or a mobile phone I understand that:

- We check with a grown up before using the internet.
- We can write kind and friendly messages and only to people we know in the real world (not just online).
- We will keep our personal information, such as our name, our password, our address, our school, our pictures, "Top Secret" and do not share on the internet.
- We tell a grown up if something we see makes us feel worried.
- We will not bring mobile phones or other electronic devices (e.g. tablets, ipods, games consoles) to school.
- I understand that the school safeguarding leads will monitor and filter my use of the school computers and can see what has been searched and/or written by me. I understand that this is to keep me and all of the children and staff safe.

I understand that these are here to keep me safe when I use technology or go online.

Children:

I have listened to and understood the pupils' e-safety agreement and I will follow the rules, which are there to keep me and the school safe.

Parents/Carers:

I have read and understood the e-safety agreement and give permission for my son / daughter to access the internet at school, and will encourage them to abide by these rules. Children will receive advice on e-safety at school.

Advice for parents is available at www.thinkuknow.org.uk/parents or by contacting the school. I understand that the school will take reasonable precautions to ensure pupils cannot access inappropriate materials.

I will encourage my child to adopt safe use of the internet and digital technologies at home and will inform the school if I have concerns over my child's e-safety. When I am given specific permission by the school to take photos at events **I will ensure that any pictures taken that include other children will not be shared using social media.**
